Marine Plumber / Marine Systems Technician

The Marine Plumber / Marine Systems Technician installs, maintains, and repairs systems and equipment including plumbing of water, fuel, hydraulic, bilge systems and related components. This position reports to the Plant Manager.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities include the following. Other duties may be assigned.

- Plan pipe system layout and complete installation according to specifications.
- Cut and thread pipes to specifications, using tools such as saws, cutting torches, pipe threaders, or pipe benders.
- Assemble or secure pipes, tubes, fittings, or related equipment, according to specifications, by brazing, cementing, soldering, or threading joints.
- Select pipe sizes, types, or related materials, such as supports, hangers, or hydraulic cylinders, according to specifications.
- Measure and mark pipes for cutting or threading.
- Inspect, examine, or test installed systems or pipe lines, using pressure gauge, hydrostatic testing, observation, or other methods.
- Lay out pipe systems, supports, and related equipment, following blueprints.
- Attach pipes to walls, structures, or fixtures, such as radiators or tanks, using brackets, clamps, tools, or welding equipment.
- Cut or bore holes in structures, such as bulkheads, decks, walls, or mains, prior to pipe installation, using hand or power tools.
- Modify, clean, and maintain pipe systems, units, fittings, and related machines and equipment, following specifications and using hand and power tools.

Requirements

- High School Diploma or graduation from certified technical school.
- 1 – 3 years marine systems experience
- Must have the ability to repetitively lift, pull and push 50+ pounds, reach above head height, stand, walk, kneel, bend and reach.
- Must have knowledge of the principles, techniques and practices involved in the installation, maintenance, repair and alteration of marine plumbing, hydraulic, bilge, and fuel systems.
- Must be able to read and understand blueprints and schematics, recognize problems through troubleshooting, and resolve systems issues.

Minimum Qualifications

- Must be 18 years of age and eligible to work in the United States.
- ABYC Marine Systems Certification *preferred*.
