**Essential Duties and Responsibilities** include the following. Other duties may be assigned.

- Build bills of materials and corresponding cost estimates based on material and equipment costs, labor hours, and non-recurring/tooling costs.
- Interpret feedback from Sales team to define associated impacts and revise specifications.
- Demonstrate high attention to detail in consistently formatting documents and documenting revisions.
- Research, analyze and interpret historical data to support cost estimates.
- Demonstrate initiative in obtaining quotes and researching vendors, subcontractors, and changes in the marine industry.
- Work closely with the Designer/Draftsman in the preparation of written specifications which accurately reflect the vessel design drawings.
- Work closely with Engineering and Production to understand manufacturing processes, material usage and labor requirements.
- Develop and update estimating tools, databases and cost estimating models.
- Attend regular Sales meetings.

## Requirements

- 1 – 3 years relevant professional experience and/or education
- MS Office proficiency (intermediate Excel)
- Marine industry experience *strongly preferred*
- Strong verbal and written communication skills
- Ability to read and interpret vessel requirements and engineering drawings
