The Fabricator completes assembly, fitting, weld preparation, and weld finishing tasks to manufacture product to specifications. This position reports to the Plant Manager.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities include the following. Other duties may be assigned.

- Layout, cut, and fit metal structures including but not limited to pipe, plate, fittings, and flanges.
- Clamp, hold, tack-weld, heat-bend, grind or bolt component parts to obtain required configurations and positions for welding.
- Operate hand tools related to the job's needs, including: saws, grinders, sanders, wheels, etc.
- Operate equipment related to the job's needs, including: forklifts, hoists, slings, press breaks, shear machine, lathe, hydraulic press (rolls).
- Use tape measures, plumbs and levels to check quality and conformance with engineering drawings.
- Perform in-process inspections to ensure quality conformance.
- Notify supervisors of faulty operation of equipment or defective material.
- Wear appropriate PPE and demonstrate safe fabricating/fitting practices.

Requirements

- High School Diploma or graduation from certified technical school.
- 1 – 3 years fabrication experience, aluminum *preferred*.
- Must have knowledge of the principles, techniques and practices involved in aluminum fabrication.
- Must be able to read and understand construction plans, possess basic mathematical skills.
- Must have the ability to repetitively lift, pull and push 50+ pounds, reach above head height, stand, walk, kneel, bend and reach.

Minimum Qualifications

- Must be 18 years of age and eligible to work in the United States.
