<b>Essential Duties:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Read and interpret layouts, engineering drawings, work orders, or verbal instructions to plan welding work.</li> <li>• Determine the appropriate welding equipment or method based on requirements, with guidance from the Welding Department Supervisor.</li> <li>• Configure and operate tools common to the welding trade, such as shielded metal arc and gas metal arc welding equipment.</li> <li>• MIG or TIG weld aluminum components using manual or semi-automatic welding equipment in various positions (vertical, horizontal, or overhead).</li> <li>• Inspect outputs to ensure they meet design specifications and applicable regulatory requirements.</li> <li>• Notify the Welding Department Supervisor of defective material or equipment.</li> <li>• Follow company procedures to maintain welding equipment.</li> <li>• Comply with safety and quality standards as required by the company and/or regulatory bodies. Demonstrate safe welding practices, and wear PPE as required by the Welding Department Supervisor and/or Safety Committee.</li> <li>• Obtain/maintain required trainings and certifications.</li> </ul>
