The Welder uses wire-feed welding equipment to weld metal components or to fill holes, indentations, or seams of fabricated metal products. This position reports to the Plant Manager.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities include the following. Other duties may be assigned.

- Weld aluminum components with welding equipment as specified by layouts, engineering drawings, work orders, or verbal instructions.
- MIG or TIG weld components in flat, vertical, or overhead positions.
- Monitor the fitting, burning, and welding processes to avoid overheating, warping, shrinking, distortion, or expansion of materials.
- Configure and operate tools common to the welding trade, such as shielded metal arc and gas metal arc welding equipment.
- Notify supervisors of faulty operation of equipment or defective material.
- Wear appropriate PPE and demonstrate safe welding practices.

Requirements

- High School Diploma or graduation from certified technical school.
- 1 – 3 years welding experience, aluminum *strongly preferred*.
- Must have knowledge of the principles, techniques and practices involved in aluminum welding, including set-up parameters (amps, volts, etc.) and equipment such as torches, torch tips, filler rods, flux, hoses, valves, and gas cylinders.
- Must be able to read and understand construction plans, welding symbols, and possess basic mathematical skills.
- Must have the ability to repetitively lift, pull and push 50+ pounds, reach above head height, stand, walk, kneel, bend and reach.

Minimum Qualifications

- Must be 18 years of age and eligible to work in the United States.
- Welding Certification *preferred*.
