Pictured below is a recently begun 47' X 15' planning cat. The vessel is a multi-function boat built to handle significant cargo and 30 passengers, and will be used to service several commercial sectors in remote Alaska. The boat will be powered by quad 300 hp Yamaha outboards and features a hydraulic bow lander door for easy loading and shore landing capability. Working in close collaboration with the client, our engineers developed a design that is purpose built to maximize all operational requirements while minimizing wasted space. This edition's Photo of the Month comes to you from Howard Tucker of Lake Union in Seattle, WA. Built in 2014, Howard's 28' mono hull is a recreational vessel intended to give their family quality time and a continuous supply of adventures out on the water. The boat's name Double Trouble was inspired by the Tucker's young twins, Jonathan and Alexsa, and was designed for maximum family comfort and safety during their outings. The vessel is powered by twin 225 hp Yamaha outboards so it has the get-up-and-go to cover some serious mileage for those times when the family wants to go exploring the waters of Puget Sound or the San Juan Islands.



The Double Trouble boasts a forward sleep cuddy and a dropdown settee for overnight accommodation; it has heat, defrost, a head, galley and plush seating for all while underway. Of course the vessel is not just all *inside* comfort; the aft deck is any fisherman's dream with down riggers, rod holder rack, fish hold lockers and an external steering and control helm.
